

Earning Credit for the QTL Summer Institute

If you are interested, you may earn either graduate credit or Continuing Education Units (CEUs) from Portland State University.

By participating in the full summer institute and completing one assignment during the Fall 2014 semester, you can earn 3 graduate credits. The assignment will be directly related to the work of the institute and something you can do as a part of your regular work as an educator. Each credit costs \$60, which means the three credits would cost \$180 per person. During the institute, you will complete a registration form, but you will not actually pay the tuition for these credits until Dec. 2014, which would be the end of the term in which you have to do the work.

OR

By participating in the institute, you can earn CEUs, which are non-credit, transcribed workshop hours. By completing a registration form at the institute and submitting a check for \$20, you will receive a transcript from PSU with 3.5 CEUs documented.

For both of these options, you will be able to sign up at the Institute as well as ask any questions you might have. You would only need to have payment ready at the institute if you plan to pay the \$20 for CEUs.
